



Back from Kenya!

The Lord blessed our return trip to Kenya! In our last communication to you we informed you that we had three objectives to accomplish on this trip:

First bless the people. **Through you the Lord provided 270 pairs of shoes, 201 Bibles and many articles of clothing -11 large suitcases in all.** In the area of Gatunbu, about 3 hours outside of Nairobi, that we ministered, this was enough to ensure that each person present received at least one material blessing. The looks on the faces of the children ranged from astonishment to pure ecstasy when they were fitted with, on some, **the first pair of shoes they have ever worn.** Some of the people had to adjust to walking with shoes on. One elderly gentleman received the nicest pair of shoes that we had and they fit him perfectly. He also received a sweater to keep him warm during the cool nights in the hill country. His constant smile while receiving God's blessings said it all. **About 50 children accepted salvation of Jesus during this event.**



Second establish a network of people in Kenya that will partner with us. Through the help of Jemimmah Marende, we visited several Kenyan government agencies and learned what it will take to form an organization that can acquire land, build buildings and do everything else necessary to **build a children's orphanage.** We are beginning to work on forming this organization now. More details to follow... We also met with a reputable builder and discussed at length the scenario of erecting the orphanage complex.

Third, we discovered that the Kenyan government would consider donating land, if available, for the purpose of it being used as a site for an orphanage. We also looked at a 4 acre tract of land in the Gatunbu area. We realized in our hearts during this trip that building an orphanage in Kenya is very doable and are excited about the doors that God has opened.

- Education in Kenya is not free. If the parents of the children can't pay and no one else pays, the children don't go to school.
