Political situation in Kenya

Some have asked how the recent riots, deaths and political and ethnic uprising in parts of Kenya are affecting our Kenya ministry. First of all, our orphanage is located in a rural, agricultural area about 1.5 hours outside of Nairobi that is populated mainly by members of the Kikuyu tribe. By all reports that area is safe and has not been directly affected.

There is always an element of danger when traveling to a foreign city such as Nairobi and the increased tension requires more wisdom. However, the situation has NOT changed God's calling for us and His or our plans for the orphanage. God is able to protect us in the fire.

Kenya orphanage update

It is clear that our Lord's hand is on the work in Kenya. The first building of the children's orphanage complex is complete and because of your giving, completely debt free in a time of rising prices and US dollar devaluation! What a blessing! The people of the community are exclaiming over the beauty and quality of this modest and simple building.

The building is sized to raise at least four to six children. One person has, by faith, already begun to sponsor [give monthly to help offset the expenses of raising] our unknown first child. Others have given to help fund the next building. For this we are grateful to God and to you, our partners.

I have seen it happen over and over, when an individual, or ministry puts complete trust in our God of unlimited resources to supply every need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus (Phil 4:10) and commit to NOT entering into debt, then the resources, including money, arrive in waves at the time of need. (Exo 35:21-36:7) The bigger the need, the bigger the wave. That is not to say that discouragement and fatigue have not tried to overcome us. They have. But discouragement and fatigue always give way to faith and steadfastness. *Phil*
