

Back to Kenya!

The date is set and the tickets are purchased for our return to Nairobi, Kenya on December 3, 2000. God provided the tickets at a sharp discount during a time of peak travel activity to that area. Janice, Joyce Marendes and I will be traveling together. Joyce is originally from Kenya and her and Janice traveled together to Kenya earlier in the year. This will my first trip to Africa.

We believe that during our time in Kenya our instructions under the Lord are to accomplish three major objectives.

First, because of your generous donations we will be taking several suitcases full of bibles, shoes and assorted clothing to give out to many poor families and homeless children. This will minister the love of Jesus and open a door for us to present His Gospel of salvation.

Second, we will be looking at some acreage that is for sale to see if the land is suitable to serve as a site for the orphanage and to grow crops to help support the orphanage.

Third, we will be meeting with various people in order to establish a network of partners in building and operating the orphanage.

At last count we had 150 pairs of shoes, 110 bibles and 5 large bags of clothing. Next week we are scheduled to pick up more items. Our goal is to take 400 pairs of shoes and 500 bibles to Kenya.
