Orphanage update!!

Praise the Lord!!! Much has happened since our last newsletter. Before we left for Kenya we received word that our Non-Governmental Organization (NGO) status had been approved. Now Through The Storm International is recognized throughout Kenya as a legal entity. Most important, we are now able to

take possession of land.

We believe that we are within days of finalizing the survey and paperwork required for transferring the 5 acres of granted land from the district of Thika to TSI. While we are waiting on the land transfer we have completed most of

the architecture design and are believing that God is providing the finances necessary to build the orphanage complex **debt-free**.

Kenya ministry update!!

On Sep 8, we traveled to Kenya with 95 Bibles, 500 pairs of shoes and assorted clothing. We went into the slums in the Kibera area in Nairobi and gave them to orphans in the commu-

nity. We ministered the Word of God and many of the children and some adults accepted Jesus as their Lord!

Because of your giving, each child received a pair of shoes or a Bible. What a joy there is in showing God's

Kibera is a community in Nairobi of more

than 1 million people crowed into a small area. The "streets" are dirt, mud & craters with waste water flowing in them. Almost none of the homes have plumbing or electricity. The homes are

made of mud or "tin" with, typically, no windows. Diseases, including a 70% HIV infection rate, are rampant.

One home, no larger than an average American kitchen that we visited, housed 11 orphans. They sleep on the floor after the furniture is moved out of the way.

- ♦ Your prayers are very, very important!! Thank you, Phil & Janice


