Kenya orphanage update

This last trip was amazing. As I mentioned earlier we were able to take in five boys!! The sixth one is coming soon.

On the morning we were to pick up the first children I was surprised at how nervous I was. I always thought that when this time came I would be very happy. I was happy, but also confronted with the realities of raising five children. For the first time I knew how a man must feel when his wife gives birth to quintuplets. Then the Lord reminded me that He has carried me this far and was not going to drop me now.

Glory to His Name! JESUS! He is sooo faithful.

When the time came for me to leave our children and head for home I had a heavy heart. I prayed that the Lord would send someone to help see that their needs were met. Just 30 minutes before leaving for the airport a young lady named Trena who I had met briefly through our friend Jennifer showed up

and told me that the Lord sent her to ask what I needed and say she would do it. Trena has been visiting the site and seeing after the needs of Dorcas and the boys. The Lord has used

Jennifer and Trena to carry out His will for these children.

Other accomplishments on this trip:

- Construction on the front and rear gates has started.
- A piece of ground is being leveled for a playground equipment.
- A hydro geological survey was done at the land site. The well will need to be about 200 meters (660 feet) deep. We are currently obtaining quotes on the drilling. We have already been given \$5,000 toward the well! Praise to the Lord!

What's next?

Our plans are to return to Kenya when the Lord provides the money needed for the well. We hope to have it around November or before but we know that the Lord's timing is perfect. We would like to complete the well, put in a playground and continue to pray about the next steps.

Future construction:

- A large kitchen and dining hall equipped to prepare and serve meals for 100 children.
- A two-story dorm for girls.
- A two-story dorm for boys.

Upon completion we want **Haven on the Hill** to be a home full of God's love for 100 children. We believe that the Lord has hand picked these kids and they will be ambassadors for Christ to Africa and the world. *Janice*
