Things are constantly changing at Haven on the Hill. Short term plans are regularly being adjusted due to changing conditions. Each new month brings new surprises, joys, challenges and achievements. Of particular joy is when we get to spend time with the 15 boys at Haven, as I (Phil) did during my recent June visit. What a delight they are to be with! They continue to surprise me with how well they can understand and speak English and bring me joy with their zeal to praise and serve our Lord! The testimonies we hear of how well they behave is uplifting. Mom Beatrice blessed me when she told me that the boys correct each other with "Daddy Phillip and Momma Janice wouldn't like you doing that."

Construction on the top floor of the children's home building is nearing completion. It is beginning to look like a home inside with the floors being laid, doors installed and the closests framed out. Janice said she walked through the unfinished home and heard the laugher and praising to the Lord by children that will soon be coming to find their lives changed forever with the love of Jesus giving them a hope for a future. Without you this could not happen. Thank you!!

We were challenged from March to May when our water well pump motor stopped working. The Haven family, as well as neighbors who come to draw water, were without our well water for 6 weeks during the longest extended drought we had seen in that area. As God would have it, almost as soon as the pump went out it started raining regularly and we were able to capture rain water to use until the pump was fixed. The Lord supplies!!! (2 Cor 8:14, Phil 4:19) Thanks for helping us get fresh water, we do not take it for granted.



Our two cows and two of our goats are happily furnishing milk for the family and manure for the Shamba (farm). The boys enjoy the continuous supply of fresh milk.

Two new Toshiba laptops were donated for the library to use for typing and computer classes. What a blessing! Tables to hold them are currently being built.

Because you care, new clothes were given to the Haven family and for the community. Everyone was overjoyed when they received the much needed new clothes and also when each boy received his own jump rope. They keep the ropes coiled and put away between uses. This was a special treat and the boys gave the Lord glory for His love.. *Phil*

Please keep Auntie Ann (our house girl) at Haven in your prayers as she is currently going through some health challenges.

Thanks! Is a small word, but if you could feel what is in our hearts you would know how BIG that word is. We thank the Lord for putting His love in your hearts and making a difference in the lives of those that have felt forgotten. 
Wanting to do great things for God?
