

In September, the government of Kenya eased restrictions on



international travel, which opened an opportunity for me to spend some time at Haven on the Hill in October, for the first time in almost exactly one year.

I met our five newest, which had arrived last December. (The younger boys are still young boys, small enough for me to pick up.)

I was very impressed with the level of maturity that our older boys gained in the last year! Kenyan schools had been closed since March and most are still closed, except for classes 4 and 8 which went back to school in October.

While I was at Haven, we received funding for a basketball court and began construction. The Haven family and I are excited about having a concrete slab and a regulation backboard and rim now that construction is complete. Most of the boys helped with the excavation and subsequent construction. (See pictures on back.)

We are getting closer to starting construction on our planned two story building designed to house our oldest boys on the bottom floor and mission teams on the top floor. The process to get county engineering approval is in progress and we hope to begin construction in March, 2021.

Our living room at Haven was half filled with school supplies, uniforms and shoes which The Plans HE Has For You Ministries had purchased and stored there, and had planned to give out last summer. Their revised plan is to give them out this month. We are grateful that The Plans He Has For You Ministries is working together with our family at Haven to bring the love of Jesus to the needy in Kenya, Africa.

Are you afraid? A lot of people have called me this past month and asked me to please pray for them because they were afraid of what is coming to America. In this uncertain time, we can be certain that Jesus loves us and died for us. We know that He holds the future and will never leave nor forsake us. 1 John 4:18 tells us that perfect love cast out fear. He never promised we would not go through the fire, but He will be there to protect us and when we come out we will not even smell like smoke! Our hope should be in Him and not a man.
