

The boys, especially the teenagers, are changing, seemingly by the day, as they charge toward adulthood.

The weather (summertime, south of the equator) was rainy on all but my last day there and was cool, bordering on requiring a jacket.

Repairs were needed to some plumbing fixtures and the roof where the chimney extends upward from the kitchen.

We are taking steps to improve our Shamba (farming) operations to increase productivity.

#### Graduations

Our first college graduate is Hezekiel Njuguna. He finished a two year course in Information Technology and is ready for the professional workforce.

Ayub Otieno and Tyson Amani finished secondary (high) school and, completed their national exams. In November, three days later, they went to work for our contractor until the next continuing education school term at either a trade school or college university, depending on their aptitudes and career desires.

Joseph Omondi and Ian Njogu finished their primary (grade) school terms and will be attending whichever high school their national exams results qualify them for.

Next year, six more boys are due to graduate high school.

#### Construction

Construction is nearing completion on the new building. We first started plans on the new building in 2019 and began construction on April 27, 2021, and now, four years after the planning started, are nearing the final finishing stage (See back page.)

Mission teams use Haven as a base to go out and bless our surrounding communities. For example, The Plans HE Has for You Ministries is now regularly reaching five schools, holding VBS, feeding and giving uniforms, shoes and more to each student at each school, along with blessing visits to local homes. The top floor of this new building will provide a space to accommodate bigger teams while they bring the salvation of Jesus to more people in the surrounding areas. *Phil*
