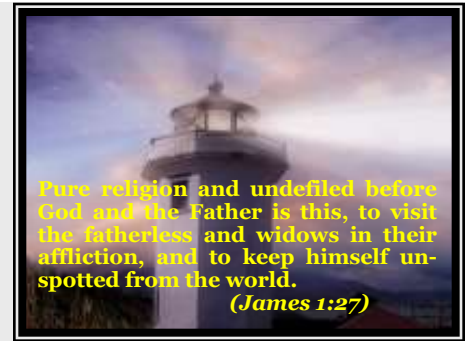

## Update on new building construction



The finishing of the ground floor of our new building had been completed and the furniture (beds, couches, tables, curtains) was delivered while I was there. What followed was a flurry of activity as the new beds were assembled, the basement beds where older boys had been sleeping were combined with the new furniture, the library was relocated to the basement, and the other older boys were relocated from the bunkhouse to the new building, all in one day. All of the

boys, young and older, pitched in.

The old library location was actually Naomi's small living room. The new basement location is roomy and more conducive to a learning environment.

The ground floor of the new building has more than enough room to accommodate our emerging young men.

The walls of the upper floor of the new building (which will be used to house visiting mission teams) had been completed and the ring beam (a band of concrete poured on top of the walls to set the roof on) was being poured when I left.

A special bonus is our contractor hired Kelvin, our oldest, while he was on school break, to help with the ring beam, so he was there for much of my stay. He is a bright, delightful, hard-working young man and it was a privilege to have him at Haven helping with the continuing build of the home that helped raise him. ## Haven building construction and funding status

Phase	Description	Status
1	Soil excavation	Complete
2	Sub-structure, including the concrete basement enclosure and ground floor slab, electric conduits and plumbing inlets/outlets	Complete
3	Septic digester for 100 – 200 people (The existing septic system is at capacity.)	Complete
4	Basement finishing and furniture (Gives us room for 12 older boys.)	Complete
5	Ground floor walling	Complete
6	Superstructure, including concrete ring beams on top of ground floor walls and concrete ground floor ceiling	Complete
7	Ground floor finishing, including doors, windows, plastering, flooring, painting, electrical	Complete
8	Top floor walling and ring beam structure	Complete.
8.5	Roofing	\$21,450-Not funded 
9	Top floor finishing	\$27,989-Not funded
10	Final landscaping, including stairs, walkways, cabinets	\$9,870-Not funded
11	Beds, Furniture, Curtains (top floor)	\$5,000 (Est)-Not funded
* Dollar amounts will vary, depending on exchange rates and cost of materials.		Total needed *: \$64,309
