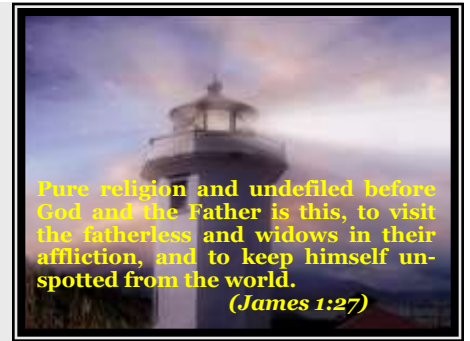

## Kenya orphanage update

In January. Kenya schools will have finally settled into a regular schedule after nearly three years of disruptions due to shutdowns and, most recently, national elections.

Our boys and young men are currently in the third trimester of their school year. Our oldest, Kelvin is in a university studying Engineering and Hezekiel is in technical school studying Information Technology.

Eleven of our young men are in high school and six more will join them in January, 2023. We have to run to keep up with their growth.

## Construction

The ground floor of the new building is currently being occupied by our older young men.

The next phase of the construction (roofing) will begin as soon as the remaining funding (\$20,400) arrives. So far, we have received \$1,050 of the \$21,450 required. We are steadfast in not starting a new phase until the funding is in place. Materials costs have increased but the value of the US dollar



is still at a high exchange rate, which, at this time, reduces the impact of inflation in Kenya for us.

We were just doing what we could in Kenya, taking food to a few homes, preaching at a few churches and the Lord always supplied what we needed through your faithfulness.

Hosting other mission teams at Haven accomplishes so much more. Some teams were able to help with construction at Haven and also go into more homes with food, blankets and the Word of God. The schools in the area were given much needed Bibles, supplies and uniforms. One team had a kitchen built at a school so the children will now have a hot meal instead of cold rice to eat for lunch. The children are able to concentrate now and learn because their stomachs are not hurting.

**Watching God's plans unfold is so amazing!** I had to repent because there was a time when I got angry when someone wanted money to build instead of feeding the hungry children. I now know that when we have a place for people to feel safe, get a hot bath and be able to eat, they are more likely to come. And when they come they can touch more lives for Jesus than just we alone can. We are still feeding families and preaching, but because of the teams coming it is magnified and we are working together to reach even more areas for Christ. Please keep us and the teams in your prayers. I believe in the power of prayer.

I want to encourage you to take time this month and tell the ones you love that you care for them and make time to spend with them. Even if it is just a phone call, that could be a big blessing to someone knowing you care and are thinking of them.

Phase	Description	Status
1	Soil excavation	Complete
2	Sub-structure, including the concrete basement enclosure and ground floor slab, electric conduits and plumbing inlets/outlets	Complete
3	Septic digester for 100 – 200 people (The existing septic system is at capacity.)	Complete
4	Basement finishing and furniture.	Complete
5	Ground floor walling	Complete
6	Superstructure, including concrete ring beams on top of ground floor walls and concrete ground floor ceiling	Complete
7	Ground floor finishing, including doors, windows, plastering, flooring, painting, electrical	Complete
8	Top floor walling and ring beam structure	Complete.
8.5	Roofing	\$20,400-Partially funded <b>We are here</b>
9	Top floor finishing	\$27,989-Not funded
10	Final landscaping, including stairs, walkways, cabinets	\$9,870-Not funded
11	Beds, Furniture, Curtains (top floor)	\$5,000 (Est)-Not funded
